Tax Free Childcare Vouchers - Parents who use the Tax Free childcare voucher to pay for their child's after school club please make sure you select Moss Park Junior School in order for payments to be made.

After school club - Please can parents send in to the school office all their bookings for the rest of the year. If you need an ad hoc booking please make sure you book at least 2 days in advance. We can still assist if you have an emergency. Cancellations need to be made at least *24 hours in advance*. If you cancel after this you may still be charged. **Please ensure children are collected and off the premises by 6.00pm at the latest. Regular late pick-ups risk losing their place.**

Collecting children - Please can parents ring the office to notify staff if their child has an appointment. You will need to show the office staff a copy of the appointment card or text message. Please ensure you collect children

promptly from school. If someone else is collecting your child, please contact the school office before 3.00pm. **If your child is unwell** (pupils should only be off for something that needs more than 'calpol and tissues' as this helps them develop good habits) **or is absent from school for an exceptional circumstance** - It is very important that you either please ring the school office and either speak to a member of staff or leave a voicemail on the absence line giving the specific reason (**Option 1**) by 9.30am. Please make sure you include full details of your child's illness.
