


Moss Park Key Knowledge

- 1. The seven continents are Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe and Australia
- 2. The five oceans are Arctic Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Pacific Ocean, Southern Ocean and Indian Ocean
- 3. The equator is an imaginary line that runs horizontally across the middle of the Earth
- 4. As you move away from the equator, the temperature drops. The coldest temperatures are towards the North and South Poles
- 5. Different animals live in different areas of the world due to climates
- 6. Some animals travel from one country to another for parts of the year, this is called migration
