

Dear Parents and Carers,

I've decided to concentrate on giving you information for the week ahead, and some information for September because there is so much going on! We have had two Year 6 Leavers' Plays, ukulele, samba and recorder concerts and Year 6 have gone off to our residential at Robinwood. What a busy week! It has been nice to see so many of you in school. I hope you have enjoyed reading your child's reports. I have seen so many fantastic examples of progress this year!

I've attached the 'School Uniform Policy on a Page'. We will hand out paper copies on Monday (when it is a bit quieter). I thought September was too late to receive this and we want to get it right from the start. We haven't made any changes. This year we are *encouraging* you to go for school shirts (long or short sleeved) as your first choice over polo shirts (which are perfectly fine). This is because we just think they are easier to tuck in so they look smarter, easier to keep white and better for pupils with sensory or allergy conditions as they are softer, cooler and lighter. I also want to draw your attention to an earrings issue. These need to be removed on PE days. We spend a lot of time (and tape) taping over pupils' ears for PE. We've been left short for first aid tape before!

Good news about the **PTFA Summer Fair**. I wanted you to know that we made almost £1300 clear profit.

Our Year 6 Enterprise Stall managed to raise £600 that will pay for next year's coach to the Year 6 Robinwood residential trip. We feel strongly that money should not be a barrier to going. We do a few things to keep the costs down that you might not know about. The team and I give up our weekend to go, which makes it much cheaper than a midweek trip. We go when many schools have finished - that brings the cost down too. We raise money every year to subsidise the coach. That's the power of 3! It saves about £100 per child every year.

Talent Show - We had over 50 different acts sign up for the Talent Show Heats. Mrs Welsh and Miss Robinson were blown away by the talents on show. We are so proud of the confidence and enthusiasm of all contestants and everyone has been given a certificate. Twelve Finalists have been announced in class and they will be performing their act to an audience of pupils on Thursday morning.

Attendance Treats - I've put these in purple so they stand out. This is how classes have decided to spend their '£10' tokens received each week they have been Attendance Champions.

Phew! I cannot believe we are in the final week. I know there will be mixed feelings, especially for our Year 6 pupils and parents. We're going to have a lovely week making memories.
